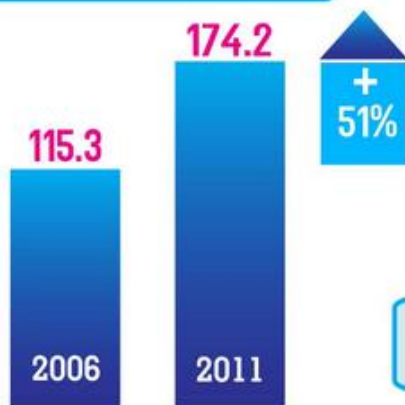
WHY YOU SHOULD STOP DRINKING BOTTLED WATER

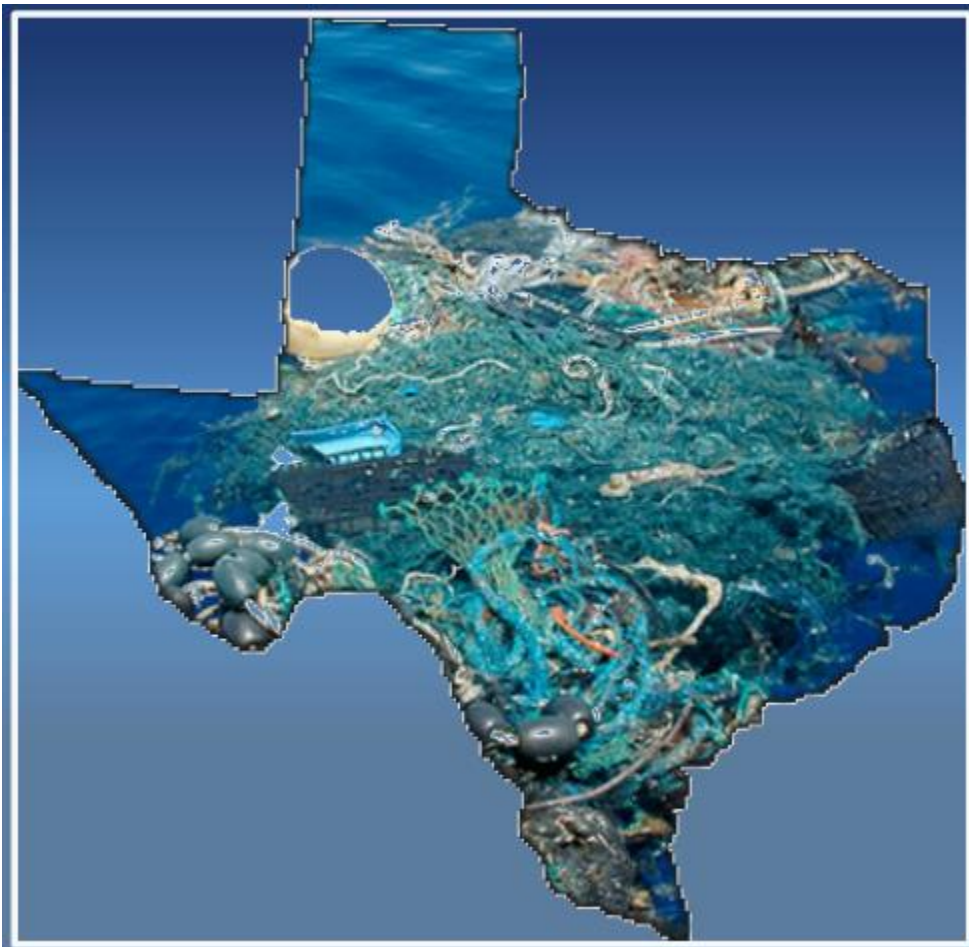

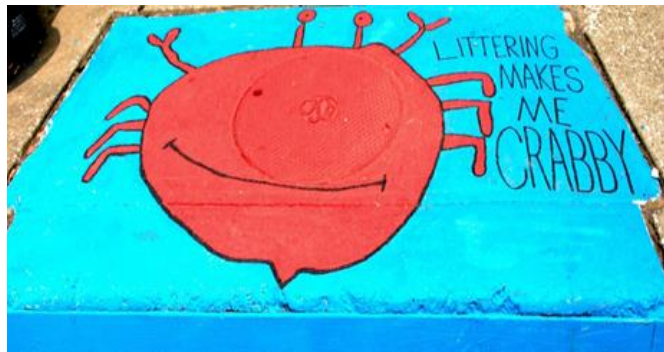

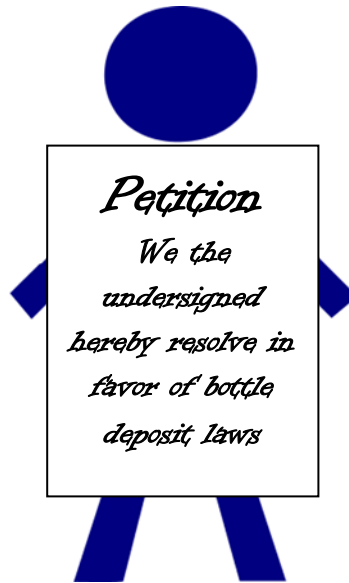
