



**DESCRIPTION AND TERMS – How to bring Follow the Water to your school:**

"Follow the Water" is a flexible, hands-on school program led by the Friends of Accotink Creek focused on watershed-based investigations, starting with the simple question, "What happens when it rains on the school, where does the water go?". This starts an investigation into how the school is connected to the local watershed, and how human activities affect the watershed. This program is built around the specific characteristics of the school campus, and school/teacher preferences, with the goal of developing a program that integrates easily into the curriculum. Activities can include stream monitoring, watershed walks, planting native watershed gardens, and schoolyard stormwater surveys.
