**Fairfax County Police, Fire and Rescue, non-emergency service, 703-691-2131;
For life threatening situation dial 911**

Animal Warden: 703-691-2131. For rabid animals, dogs running loose, etc.

Audubon Naturalist Society: 703-803-8400. Help you find the right contact.

Erosion in areas greater than 2500 square feet or in Resource Protection Area along streams, 703-324-1937. Please turn in violators when you see violations, such as a silt fence with a break or is down. Sediment can quickly smother and destroy the life in a stream.

Erosion along the roadside, such as a ditch, call VDOT, 703-383-2888.

Hazardous Materials: 911 for life threatening situation or Fire Marshall-703-246-4386 (24 hours); non-emergency-703-691-2131.

Health Department: 703-246-2300. When dumping or anything else becomes a health issue, these people will help or refer you to someone who can.

Illegal Dumping: 703-691-2131. When dumping is in progress, note the nearest address and call right away, Fairfax County Police, Fire and Rescue. If the dumping may be a health hazard, such as tires with standing water, call the Health Department, 703-246-2300.

Local media: Notify local newspapers when something bad or good is happening in our watershed.
